



Philomath Community Foundation Philomath Forward Scholarship

The Philomath Community Foundation (PCF) will award this scholarship to a Philomath School District (PSD) graduating senior.

The Philomath Forward Scholarship is a \$1,500 per year over a 4-year time span (maximum of \$6,000) Scholarship. This Scholarship was initiated to provide a way for PSD alumni, community members and others who have received generous support throughout the years to give back to the community, while at the same time providing support to students to continue their post high school educational pursuits.

Eligibility requirements

Applicant must have:

- 1. Attended, in person, schools in the Philomath 17J district for four complete academic years;*
- 2. Graduated, or is on track to graduate, from a Philomath 17J high school;*
- 3. Scholarship to be used at any accredited institution of higher learning, trade school or other post-secondary accredited occupational training; Applicant will attach a written explanation of post high school educational plans;*
- 4. Note: For continued eligibility, the Recipient must maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average (gpa) of 2.00 (or equivalent) each term/semester of their post high school educational pursuits over the maximum 4-year time span. The applicant will be responsible for reporting their gpa at the end of each term/semester to PCF to receive funding for the following term. Attach a statement that, if awarded this scholarship, the applicant will comply with these reporting criteria.*

Selection Criteria

Awardee(s) of the scholarship will be selected at random from all applications received by the application deadline and which meet the eligibility requirements.

Please include:

- A copy of the applicant's transcript(s) satisfying eligibility requirements 1 and 2;*
- A written explanation of post high school plans satisfying eligibility requirement 3;*
- A statement indicating that the applicant, if awarded this scholarship, will comply with the reporting procedures as outlined in #4, above, to remain eligible for future scholarship funding.*

The completed application, including all required attachments, must be submitted to the Philomath High School Guidance Center by April 15th prior to 3:00 pm. (If the 15th falls on a weekend, the due date for the application packets will be the following Monday prior to 3:00 pm).

Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
